

**Professor Salim T S Al-Hassani** is an Emeritus Professor (Mechanical Engineering), currently an Honorary Professorial Fellow at the School of Languages, Linguistics and Cultures, Faculty of Humanities, University of Manchester. Since 1968, he worked at British and Middle Eastern Universities, and Industry. He has published over 200 papers in international journals and books and has supervised 40 PhD, 50 MSc students and numerous post-doctoral Fellows from various parts of the world. He was director in a number of educational and engineering consulting companies, served as expert witness in major litigations and had numerous academic, industrial and public awards and had a few patents to his name.

Presently, he is the **Honorary Chairman** of the Foundation for Science, Technology and Civilisation (FSTC), UK.
